

HELICOPTER-BORNE SURVEY NOTIFICATION FEBRUARY - APRIL 2025

Gold and Copper Resources Pty Limited (GCR) manage multiple exploration licenses exploring for gold and copper in the NSW Central West. GCR will be undertaking a helicopter-borne magnetic-radiometric (mag-rad) survey from February to April 2025.

What is a helicopter-borne mag-rad survey?

A mag-rad survey utilizes state-of-the-art technology mounted onto a helicopter to detect extremely small variations in the earth's magnetic field and emissions of naturally occurring radiation from the earth's surface.

Why is the survey being flown?

The survey is being flown to develop a better understanding of the surface and near surface geology by using the magnetic and radiometric measurements to map the rocks, which is an essential part of the exploration process. A helicopter borne survey is an effective way of covering a very large area in a short time and enables consistent regional coverage over varied landscapes.

What does the helicopter look like?

The survey will be carried out by a helicopter fitted with a boom carrying the measurement equipment.



How high will the helicopter fly?

The helicopter will fly approximately 30m above the ground along 50m spaced lines in an east west

When will the survey begin and how long will it take?


The survey is expected to begin in early February 2025 and take up to 3 months to complete, dependent on favourable weather.

Will the survey disturb my animals and

There will be noise as the helicopter passes overhead and this has the potential to disturb sensitive animals. Owners should take care to ensure the safety of their animals during the flyover.

Where will the survey take place?

The survey is being flown in an area roughly bounded by the towns of Rockley, Mount David, Trunkey Creek, and Newbridge as shown in the diagram below. Towns will not be directly overflown.
